

- The Los Alamitos Education Association's (LAEA) Initial Proposal for 2022-23 to the Los Alamitos Unified School District: Ms. Stacy Schmitz, LAEA President
 - LAEA proposed to open negotiations for the 2022-23 school year on Article V, Hours of Employment and Duties.
- The Los Alamitos Unified School District's Initial Proposal for 2022-23 to the Los Alamitos Education Association: Dr. Joe Fraser, Assistant Superintendent, Human Resources

- Proposed Los Alamitos Unified School District Annual Budget for the 2022-23 Fiscal Year: Ms. Elvia Galicia, Assistant Superintendent, Business Services
 - During her presentation, Ms. Galicia provided an overview of the 2022-23 Governor's May Budget Revision and Fiscal Outlook, which is what the District uses to base the budget on.
 - She noted that school districts in California are required by statute to adopt an annual budget by July 1 even though the State's budget, by which K-12 public education is funded, may not be finalized by that date.
 - The Board will adopt the final proposed budget at the June 28, 2022 Board of Education meeting.
- **Presentation of Supplemental Materials and Textbook:** Mrs. Ondrea Reed, Deputy Superintendent
 - Mrs. Reed presented the following materials and textbook, which will be on review at the District Office for the next 30 days.
 - Sonday LPL System 1, 2 and 3 to be used in grades UTK-8 to be used in structured, systematic reading intervention.
 - National Geographic World of Chemistry, which will be used at LAHS for College Prep Chemistry course.
